

## CPNRD-RON BISHOP COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Central Platte Natural Resources District's college scholarship program was implemented in 2007 and has provided scholarships to 135 students. In 2014, the scholarship name was changed to the CPNRD-Ron Bishop College Scholarship to honor former manager, Ron Bishop, who managed Central Platte NRD from 1972-2013.

Applicants are ranked based on major and essay response. Must be a college sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student seeking a natural resources degree. Five (5) scholarships will be awarded at \$1,000 per student for the 2025-2026 school year. Return applicants and recipients are eligible to apply.


